### Position Overview

The Ministry Stream Leader will represent Connecting Stream's ministry by leading, coaching and overseeing a team of volunteers going into a specific stream of ministry. Within a ministry stream with more than one team, responsibilities include coaching and overseeing additional team leaders, but will not typically involve leading more than one team within the ministry stream.

### Responsibilities

- Give leadership to Connecting Streams volunteers, and act as a liaison with respective organizations, and agencies
- Represent Connecting Streams to volunteers, organizations, and agencies
- Supervise, educate and coach team leaders and volunteers within a specific ministry stream
- Liaisons, debrief, and trouble shoot for the volunteers/agencies/organizations involved in a specific ministry.
- Partner with the Volunteer Coordinator to transition new volunteers into their respective roles
- Brainstorm with leadership team/agencies to develop new strategic ministry opportunities.
