Position Overview

Plant a dynamic, new church in an unreached part of your city or community. If you have a heart for ministry or you're an aspiring church planter, Vision 360 has the tools you need to respond to God's call. The City Catalyst will have primary responsibility for serving and empowering a collaborative church planting community in their city.

Responsibilities

Recruitment and retention:

- Work with the Regional Catalyst to recruit a Visionary Catalyst(s) for the city.
- Work with the City Visionary(s) to build a board of business and ministry leaders whose primary purpose will be to develop and implement the Strategic Ministry Plan for their city. (e.g. church plant objectives and funding goals, etc.)
- Recruit and work with a Visionary Catalyst(s), Prayer Catalyst and City Global Catalyst.
- Recruit, qualify and support prospective church planters utilizing the Vision360 services of Assessment, Training, Coaching, Resourcing and Connecting.
- Establish a network for on-going mentoring and care for church planting families.
- Member of the local board.

Assessment and Coaching:

- Helping the church determine the next steps needed to plant a new church.
- Locate the church catalysts and challenge them to help in the process
- Encourage the leaders in the process of planting a church

Tipping point Commitment and Training:

- Committing to three years with a church to help in the planting process

- Raise money for the new church plant and funding needed.
- Monthly training with the leaders of the church

Other:

- Creating contacts in various areas to see where there is a church planting vision
- Sharing the national vision with different churches and leaders.
- Provide assistance to other regions of Vision360 as needed.
