Position Overview

Reporting to the iTV Director, the Video Producer will oversee each project from conception to completion, ensuring that all videos are properly filmed, edited and posted onto the website in a timely manner and within budget.

Responsibilities

Filming:

- Work with the Script Writer to create material for iTV.
- Initiate ideas and create video projects.
- Work with Videographer and Studio Manager to shoot the episodes for iTV.

Editing:

- Inserting music, dialogue, and sound effects, arranging scenes into sequences, and correcting errors using editing equipment.

- Cutting shot sequences to different angles at specific points in scenes, making each individual cut as fluid and seamless as possible.
- Creation of post-production graphics, if applicable.

Uploading:

- Create the final cut of videos.
- Compress videos into appropriate formats for web delivery.
- Uploading videos to correct placement.
- Tracking videos to ensure that they are functioning correctly.

Education and Experience:

- A basic knowledge of video production.
- A degree (or working on a degree) in Communications, Theatre, Film, or Media
- Photography – production still shots (your portfolio will be requested)
- Basic knowledge of post-production graphics and motion graphics is an asset.

- Able to work both independently and with a team.
- Leadership skills to oversee support workers.
- Contemporary technical skills and troubleshooting abilities.
