- Lead Bible Studies and engaging in discipleship with athletes and coaches
- Speak at pre-game chapels and team meetings
- Train and equip student athletes for multiplying ministry
- Work closely with churches and youth pastors in the community to ensure opportunity for Christian athletes to use their platform in the community
- Challenge and recruit athletes to international tours, projects, national retreats, conferences and camps
- Work closely with other regional Athletes in Action campus staff and other campus ministries

Other (20%):

- Attend and help lead at national and international Athletes in Action projects and events
- Help lead, instruct and counsel at Athletes in Action youth camps during the summer months
